We are a small press producing cutting-edge scholarship that has a global reach and critical profile characteristic of a much larger organization, while we also design our books to a high standard. Our fields of expertise are, inter alia, Luso-Hispanic studies, Latin American studies, eighteenth-century studies, and Irish writers.
