## ***Colloquium: “Changes” in Physical Education with Linkage to Health: Practical Implementations from Local to Global***

### ***Prof Dr Ming-kai Chin Biography***

Prof. Dr. Ming-kai Chin received his B.Sc. in teaching of physical education from University of Tennessee-Knoxville; MA in administration of physical education and sports from Springfield College; Ph.D. in exercise physiology from University of Wisconsin-Madison and MBA from Southern Illinois University-Carbondale, USA. Previously he served as the Head of Sports Science at the Hong Kong Sports Institute; Head and Principal Lecturer, Department of Physical Education and Sports Science at the Hong Kong Institute of Education; and Professor, School of Health, Physical Education and Leisure Services, University of Northern Iowa, USA. Currently, he is the Vice President, Global Affairs and Research, HOPSports, Inc. in Las Vegas, USA. An editor of 8 books and author of over 190 publications in scientific and sports journals (English and Chinese) and 14 educational CD-ROMs, Prof. Chin has offered over 130 keynote and invited presentations, and over 90 conference paper presentations globally. A Fellow of AIESEP and Research Consortium of AAHPERD, he is one of the four Founders and former President (2005-08), former Secretary General (2009-2011) of Asian Council of Exercise and Sports Science (ACCESS); Editor-in-Chief of the Asian Journal of Exercise and Sports Science (AJESS) since 2002, one of the two Founders of Global Forum of Physical Education Pedagogy (GoFPEP) in 2010, 2012, 2014 and 2016 in USA, Germany, South Africa and Turkey respectively.

He was the former Sports Science Course Director for the Hong Kong Olympic Academy, Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong-China. Prof. Chin is the Founding President of BRICS Council of Exercise and Sports Science (BRICSCESS) and the recipient of the Medal of Manuel Gomes Tubino award by FIEP in 2015. Prof. Chin's keen interest is to promote health and wellness of children and community through global international co-operation with interdisciplinary approach by involving researchers, young scholars and students.
