

## **CALL OF APPLICATIONS - DVC POSTGRADUATE MASTERS STUDENT FUNDING FOR THE 2022 ACADEMIC YEAR IN THE FACULTY OF EDUCATION**

The Faculty of Education is pleased to announce a call for new applications for MEd student funding for the 2022 academic year. The applications are open to full-time and part-time South African and permanent residents who are financially needy (i.e., those whose combined household family income is less or equal to R350 000 per annum).

**Funding will be awarded for the 2022 academic only, for students who meet the following criteria:**

- Student's first year of enrolment in the MEd programme must be the 2022 academic year
- Student cannot be a recipient of other sources of funding
- Student cannot be employed in the UWC Work Study programme, e.g. as a Student Assistant, Tutor or Teaching Assistant
- Student with a combined household income of less or equal to R350 000 per annum

**Successful applicants will be funded the full tuition costs, subject to the availability of funds**

**NB: ALL SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT TO REGISTER FOR EVERY YEAR REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE DEGREE AS SPECIFIED BY THE FACULTY.**

Applicants must be in good academic standing.

**Successful applicants will be required to also submit the following documents:**

- Proof of admission
- Confirmation of banking details (not older than 3 months)
