Competition Rules

1. Applicants must be registered as a student at University of the Western Cape but can be studying any discipline at any level.
2. All pieces must be the original and unaided work of the author with the exception of the Translation Prize, which can be a collaboration, the prize money to be shared equally.
3. All work must be 1.5 spaced on one side of A4 paper.
4. If submitting poetry in more than one language category, no single poem may be longer than 40 lines.
5. Prose pieces must be no longer than 3,000 words and may take the form of short fiction or creative non-fiction.

6. Work must be submitted in hard copy to Avril Grovers in the CMDR office, upstairs in the B-Block, Room B223 by 12 noon on the closing date. No entries will be considered after this point.
7. All entries must be accompanied by a completed application form.
8. No applicant may submit more than one entry per language category
9. No work delivered later than this time and date will be considered for a prize.
10. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
